

Agreement on guest researchers of Kumamoto University Center for Marine Environment Studies

(enacted on July 27th, 2004).

(Objectives)

1. In accordance with Article 8.3 of the Regulation of Kumamoto University Center for Marine Environment Studies, agreement hereby stipulates provisions relevant to guest researchers of Kumamoto University Center for Marine Environment Studies (hereinafter referred to as "Center").

(Application)

2. The person engaged in activities of Center as guest researchers shall submit an application (format given in Appendix 1st) together with personal vitae (format given in Appendix 2nd) to the Director of Center.

(Selection process)

3. Director of Center shall recommend applicants submitting the above-mentioned document to Steering Committee of Center for Marine Environment Studies (hereinafter referred to as "Steering Committee").

(Period of acceptance)

4. The period of acceptance of guest researchers shall be defined as from the beginning day of acceptance until the end of the day in the next academic year. The period shall be renewed in case of necessity.

(Treatments)

5. Kumamoto University (hereinafter referred to as "University") shall not be responsible for any damages or disadvantages brought to guest researchers from matters that do not result from mismanagement of University. The salary or necessary expenses related to guest researchers shall not be charged against Center.

(Cooperation)

6. Guest researchers shall cooperate with Center staff for research promotion.

(Disclosure of research)

7. In case of disclosure of research data through cooperative research activities, guest researchers shall require the approval of Director.

(Miscellaneous)

8. Besides the Agreement, the Steering Committee shall stipulate additional provisions further related to guest researchers.

(Enforcement of the Agreement)

9. The Rule shall become effective on July 27th, 2004. After the enforcement, the period of acceptance of the first guest researchers shall be effective until March 31, 2006, notwithstanding the 4th provision above.

Supplementary provision stipulated on September 27, 2005.

The rule shall become effective on September 27, 2005.

Supplementary provision stipulated on June 8, 2006.

The rule shall become effective on June 8, 2006.
